6. ☐ Thank God for one specific skill He gave you.
7. ☐ List your five talents: money, skills, time, network, influence.
8. ☐ Identify one talent you are burying out of fear.
9. ☐ Take one concrete step to put that buried talent to work.
10. ☐ Review your pricing and ask if it honors the value you deliver.
11. ☐ Find one place your scale is slightly off and write the fix.
12. ☐ Make that one thing right, even if it costs you.
13. ☐ Tell the truth in a spot where exaggeration would be easier.
14. ☐ Read Proverbs 11:1 and pray for honest scales.
15. ☐ Decide your business giving percentage and where it goes.
16. ☐ Give something this week before you feel ready.
17. ☐ Bless a customer with something extra they did not pay for.
18. ☐ Write a thank you to someone who helped you build.
19. ☐ Count the cost of your next big move on one page.
20. ☐ Ask one wise person for counsel on a current decision.
21. ☐ Map your next three moves in order.
22. ☐ Pray over your business plan and commit it to God.
23. ☐ Serve one person for free this week with your skill.
24. ☐ Forgive a customer or partner who wronged you.
25. ☐ Rest one full day and trust God with the outcome.
26. ☐ Encourage one other entrepreneur in their calling.
27. ☐ Review the week: where did you work as worship?
28. ☐ Give God the credit for one specific win.
29. ☐ Write what you have learned about stewardship this month.

30. ☐ Recommit your work to the Lord and begin again tomorrow.
