7. ☐ Draft a simple 90 day budget.
8. ☐ Pray over your finances and ask for diligence.
9. ☐ Calculate your true profit margin honestly.
10. ☐ Set a fixed percentage to save off the top.
11. ☐ Open or choose the account that holds your reserve.
12. ☐ Read Genesis 41 and learn from Joseph's one fifth.
13. ☐ List the taxes you genuinely owe and when.
14. ☐ Find one lawful deduction you are not yet using.
15. ☐ Set up a simple system for receipts and records.
16. ☐ Read Matthew 22:21 on rendering to Caesar and God.
17. ☐ Set your giving percentage in advance, off the top.
18. ☐ Name the storehouse your giving supports.
19. ☐ Make one gift before you feel ready.
20. ☐ Read Malachi 3:10 and consider God's invitation to test Him.
21. ☐ List any bad debt you carry and its real cost.
22. ☐ Write one step to escape that debt.
23. ☐ Plan one wise, intentional way to multiply what you have.
24. ☐ Read Proverbs 22:7 on the borrower and the lender.
25. ☐ Decide one way to keep money a servant, not a master.
26. ☐ Rest and trust God as your provider.
27. ☐ Help another owner set up a simple budget.
28. ☐ Review one subscription or cost you can cut.
29. ☐ Write what you learned about stewardship this month.
