8. ☐ Break one area into clear, owned roles.
9. ☐ Give one person real authority, not just tasks.
10. ☐ Find where ownership is fuzzy and clarify it.
11. ☐ Read Nehemiah 3 and notice the assigned sections.
12. ☐ Name one person with potential others overlook.
13. ☐ Invest concretely in that person this week.
14. ☐ Thank a Barnabas who once believed in you.
15. ☐ Restore someone gently who failed under you.
16. ☐ Name one conflict you have been avoiding.
17. ☐ Go directly and privately to that person.
18. ☐ Aim to win the person, not the argument.
19. ☐ Read Matthew 18:15 and follow its order.
20. ☐ Welcome one piece of honest, sharpening feedback.
21. ☐ Ask what would break if you stepped away for a season.
22. ☐ Name who could carry the most critical work.
23. ☐ Begin preparing that successor on purpose.
24. ☐ Document one thing that lives only in your head.
25. ☐ Draft your one page Leadership and Multiplication plan.
26. ☐ Rest and lead from a full cup, not an empty one.
27. ☐ Wash someone's feet, serve beneath your title.
28. ☐ Encourage a younger leader to lead.
29. ☐ Write what you learned about leadership this month.

30. ☐ Commit your leadership to the Lord and begin again tomorrow.
